home, if possible.

- Try not to say "goodbye" when you leave after dropping off your child. Instead say something like, "I can't wait to hear about your first day".

- Remind your child that the teachers know they will be anxious and that they will make sure they are comfortable. If your child is worried, ask them what is bothering them and role play solutions.
- Discuss with your child the positive aspects of school—meeting new friends, playing with new toys, doing arts/crafts, etc.
